

Here are the ANSWERS. NOTE: with some of the questions, there may be more than one possible answer.

Example: Yes, I am a student. *Are you a student?*

1. Yes, I am a teacher. *Are you a teacher?*
2. No, I'm not going to London. *Are you going to London?*
3. Yes, he's making a cake. *Is he making a cake?*
4. No, she's not playing tennis. *Is she playing tennis?*
5. Yes, you're in the classroom. *Am I in the classroom?*
6. Yes, we're learning maths tomorrow. *Are we learning maths tomorrow?*
7. No, they were not having English lessons. *Were they having English lessons?*
8. No, I wasn't reading any fantasy books. *Were you reading any fantasy books?*
9. Yes, we were in London yesterday. *Were you in London yesterday?*
10. Yes, she was cooking dinner last Sunday. *Was she cooking dinner yesterday?*

Example: Yes, I can play tennis. *Can you play tennis?*

1. Yes, I can play the piano. *Can you play the piano?*
2. Yes, we can take the train to the airport. *Can we take the train to the airport?*
3. No, we don't have to do our homework. *Do we have to do our homework?*
4. Yes, she will drive you to work. *Will she drive me/us to work?*
5. No, they won't open the doors. *Will they open the doors?*
6. Yes, you may open the window. *May I/we open the window?*
7. Yes, we should tell them the news. *Should we tell them the news?*
8. No, we didn't have to buy those shoes. *Did we have to buy those shoes?*
9. Yes, they drove all the way to Italy last week. *Did they drive all the way to Italy last week?*
10. Yes, they forgot to tell Simon about the meeting yesterday afternoon. *Did they forget to tell Simon about the meeting yesterday afternoon?*

Example: The meeting is at six o'clock. *When is the meeting or what time is the meeting?*

1. We have to start lessons at 12 o'clock. *When do we have to start lessons? What time do we have to start lessons?*
2. The green car is the Ford. *Which car is the Ford? Which one is the Ford?*
3. I don't know what we have to do. *What do we have to do? Do you know what we have to do?*
4. The school is in the centre of the village. *Where is the school?*
5. Mr. Smith will be giving you English lessons today. *Who will be giving me/us English lessons today?*
6. Because our car has broken down, we have to take the bus to school. *Why do we have to take the bus to school?*
7. I need your homework ready by Friday. *When do you need our homework? When do you need our homework ready by?*
8. It's my new machine for making cakes. *What is that? What is that machine?*
9. The man in the green jacket stole the money. *Who stole the money? Which man stole the money?*
10. Tokyo is in Japan. *Where is Tokyo?*
11. You have to press these two buttons there, and there. *What do I have to do? How does it work? How does this machine work? Which/what buttons do I have to press?*
12. Because you're only seven, and education is important. *Why do I have to go to school?*
13. We had to finish the project last Monday. *When did you have to finish the project?*
14. The TV remote control was down the side of the chair. But I have it now. *Where was the TV remote control?*
15. Sam broke the window. *Who broke the window?*
16. He used milk, eggs, flour and a little salt to make pancakes. *How did he make pancakes? What did he use to make pancakes?*

## And now, let's mix them all up!

1. You have to finish dinner by 1 o'clock. *When do I/we have to finish dinner?*
2. Yes, it can also make waffles. *Can it also make waffles?*
3. No, they aren't going to university next year. *Are they going to university next year?*
4. They should go to the church with the three big doors at the front. *Which church should they go to? What should they do?*
5. Tim Berners-Lee invented the World Wide Web. *Who invented the World Wide Web?*
6. Yes, they could drive down Main Street and not on London Road. *Could they drive down Main Street and not London Road?*
7. The leisure centre's only 500 metres from here. *Would you like me to tell you how to get there? Where's the leisure centre? Could you tell me where the leisure centre is? Is the leisure centre around here?*
8. No, it isn't important that we wear formal clothes for the party. *Is it important that we wear formal clothes for the party?*
9. No, I haven't got Windows 10 yet. *Have you got Windows 10? Do you have Windows 10?*
10. I don't have enough money to buy an i-phone! *Do you have enough money to buy an i-phone? Have you got enough money to buy an i-phone?*
11. Because it's dangerous not to wear a safety hat when you are using heavy machines. *Why do I have to wear a safety hat (when using heavy machines)?*
12. The best time would be to do your homework as soon as you get home. *When would be the best time to do my/our homework?*
13. Yes, they missed their flight. *Did they miss their flight?*
14. Because he didn't want to use the bus, so that's why he was late. *Why was he late?*
15. I was at the front of the bus! Didn't you see me? *Where were you?*
16. If I gave you a hundred pounds, you would spend it all in five minutes! *Why didn't you give me a hundred pounds?*
17. He told me yesterday morning. *When did he tell you?*
18. No, she wasn't going to send me a text message. *Was she going to send you a text message?*
19. Yes, she's going to call me next Saturday. *Is she going to call you (next Saturday)?*
20. Because I can read maps. I don't need any electronic devices in my car to tell me how to get to places. *Why don't you get a Sat-nav/GPS?*
